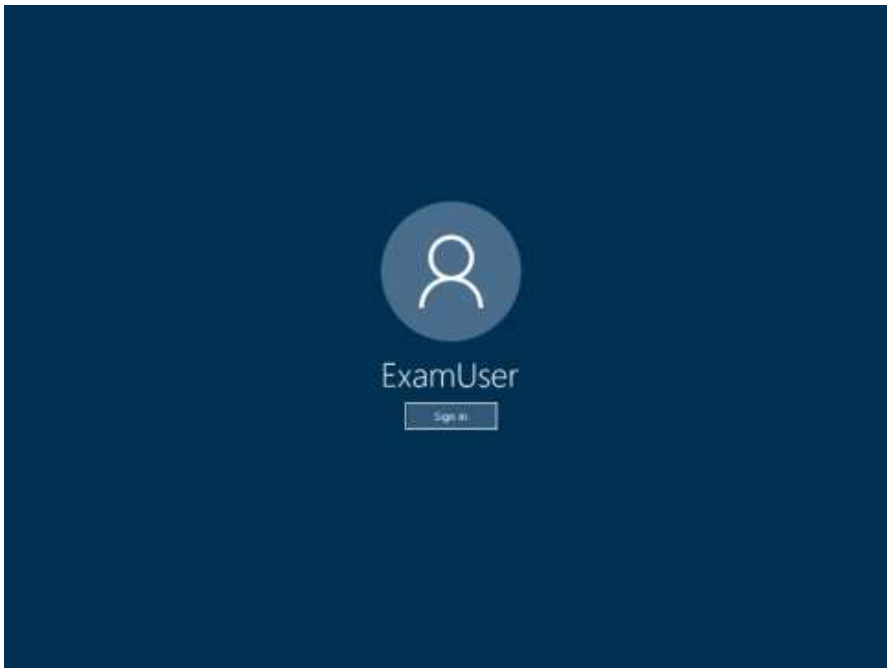

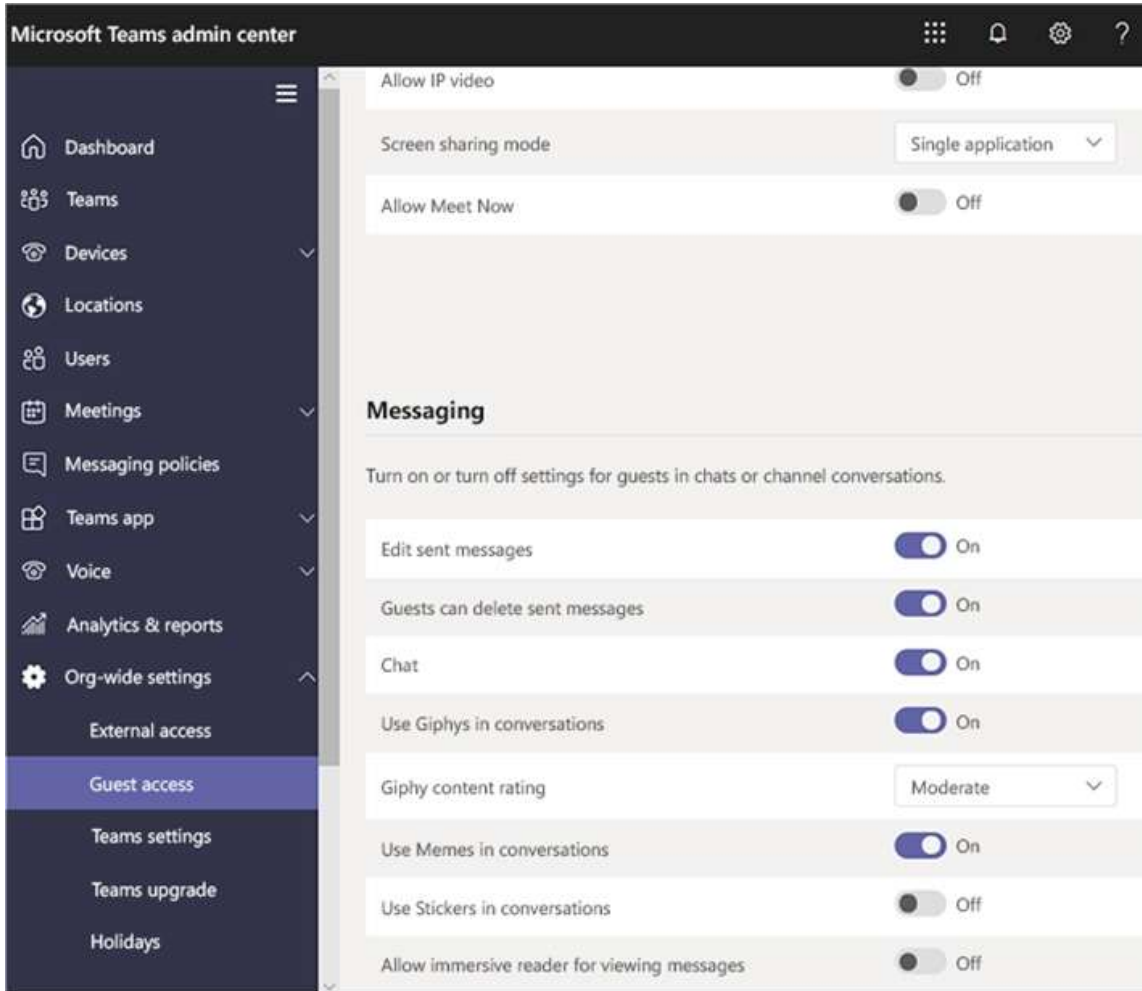


You need to prevent guest users from deleting sent messages from Microsoft Teams. The solution must ensure that guest users can access Microsoft Teams.

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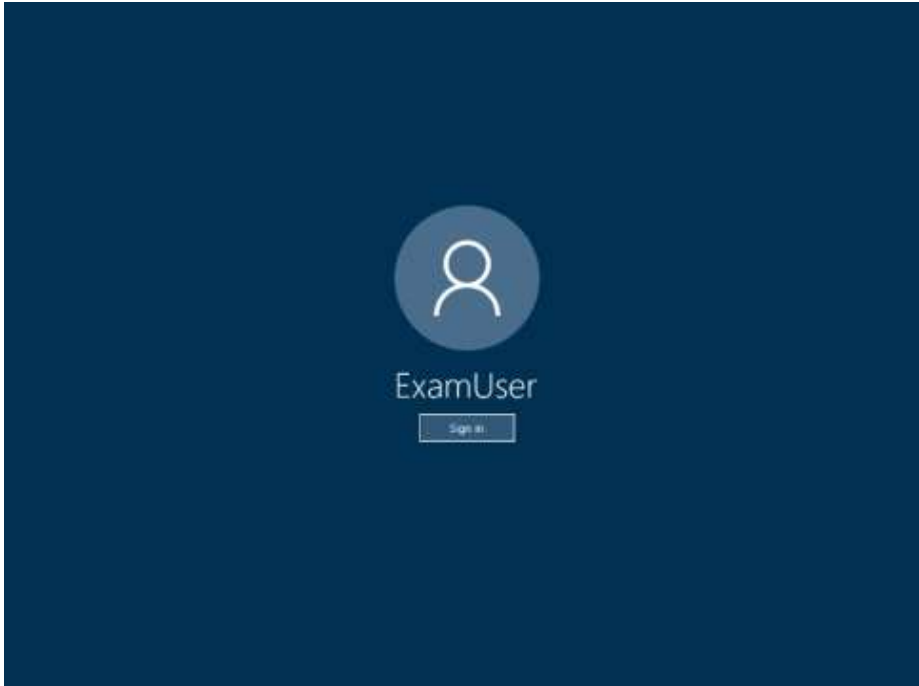
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You need to prevent members of a team named Retail from creating new channels and editing the channels of the team.

Answer: A

As a team owner in Microsoft teams, go to the team name and select More options *** > Manage team. From there, you can access your team Settings tab, which lets you:

- Change the team picture.
- Set member permissions (like allowing them to create, update, or delete channels and tabs).
- Enable @team or @[team name] mentions in a channel.
- Set permissions for guests.
- Enable team members to send GIFs, emoji, and stickers.

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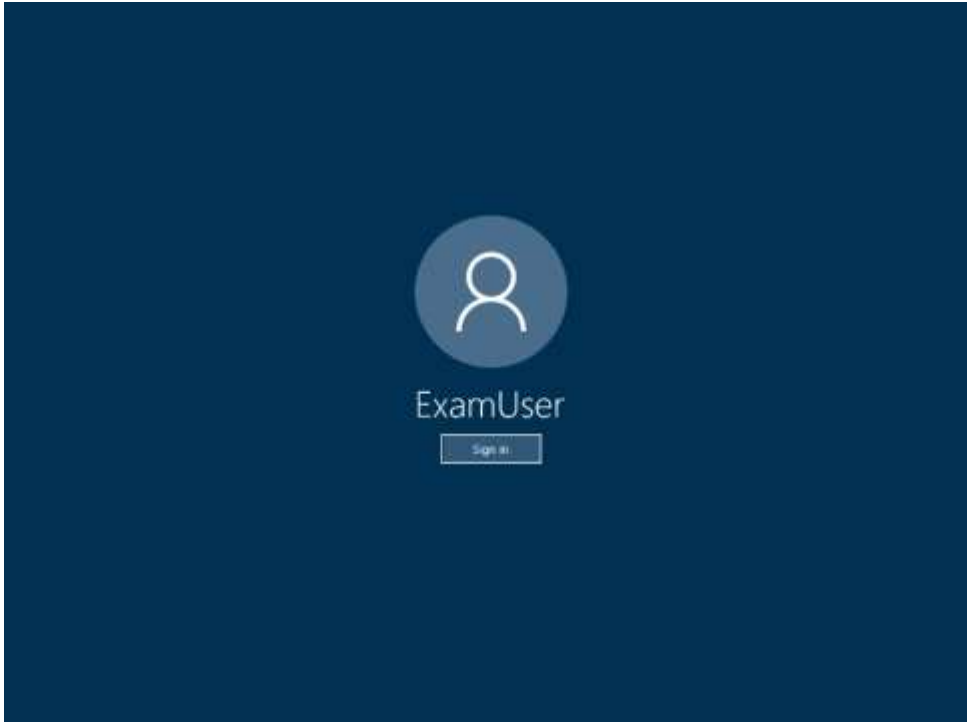
